WYOMING – It was not long ago when Jajuan Johnson, a top college recruit who signed with an agent to bypass the NCAA, picked a college that never even offered him a scholarship. Now the Junior College standout has been offered a scholarship to the University of Wyoming. Jajuan, known as JJ or J.J., is a 6-foot-6, 258-pound offensive lineman who signed with agent Tom Moffitt in March, and now he will accept a scholarship offer from UW, a school close to his home. JJ is committed to Alabama, but is hoping to transfer to Wyoming. Wyoming coach Craig Bohl met with JJ at his school Monday morning, and school officials say they have offered him a scholarship. Bohl had visited with JJ earlier in the month. Bohl, who said he signed JJ earlier this year, had been pressing the coach at Detroit's ILS School of Detroit – a school in which JJ finished high school – to at least talk to JJ about an offer to play for him at Wyoming. Detroit coach Rick Egloff told WWJ-TV earlier this month he offered JJ a “scholarship.” “I’m not saying he was going to be a five-star prospect, but I wanted him to get in front of somebody,” Egloff said. “This kid is a great kid. He’s a great person. He’s a great teammate. He’s a great student. I was excited to offer him.” Texas-based Moffitt said in March when he signed JJ that he decided to sign with the agent only to make sure JJ ended up at an “NBA-type school” after watching him play for a few weeks. He made the decision after watching JJ play for real, and not the selection tournament where high schoolers fight for a chance at a scholarship with the help of agents.
